


*Note: Maternal and child hubs have midwifery equipment and are accessible to LMC midwives in case of rapid births. However, because they are not planned places of birth, they have no more equipment than an ambulance carries.*



You live in Wanaka, plan to birth at Alexandra or Dunedin but birth is progressing rapidly

Contact your LMC midwife urgently – she will assess you, coordinate your care and provide some care.

LMC assesses you at home – decision to stay at home to give birth or arrange emergency transport to planned place of birth.

LMC assesses you at Wanaka Maternal and Child Hub – arranges emergency transport to planned place of birth.

LMC assesses you at Wanaka Maternal and Child Hub and baby is coming quickly. Give birth at hub and then transfer to Charlotte Jean Maternity Hospital in Alexandra or Dunedin Hospital for inpatient postnatal care (or go straight home if no inpatient postnatal care wanted)

Inpatient postnatal care after your baby is born at Charlotte Jean Maternity Hospital in Alexandra, or Dunedin Hospital (or go/remain at home if no inpatient postnatal care wanted).

At-home postnatal care from your midwife for four to six weeks following your baby's birth
