

Key Messages June 2022

- ◆ CHC was happy to welcome Mata Cherrington, Chief Māori Health Strategy and Improvement Officer, to our meeting. Mata explained Te Whare Tapa Wha to members, and stated it is imperative that the community voice is heard
- ◆ Peter Crampton and Talis Liepens updated members on the Strategic Refresh work which is continuing, to inform Health NZ. Health Needs Assessment is being formally launched
- ◆ Director of Quality and Clinical Governance provided information about the work continuing around patient safety, DHB Risk Register, and methods of collecting data to determine staff and patient satisfaction. He spoke of the need to embed consumers across all levels of the system, and equity needed further work
- ◆ Regular update from chair of the Disability Working Group
- ◆ Chris Fleming, CEO of SDHB gave his final briefing to CHC – this centred around Health NZ and priorities for the interim District Directors. Chris was thanked by all CHC members for his support since 2017
- ◆ Andrew Swanson-Dobbs, CE of WellSouth spoke of several workstreams that will require CHC input. He also updated members on the progress with Hokonui runanga and Localities planning.
