Measles is a serious disease and is highly infectious. If you were born between 1989 and 2004 you may not have been fully immunised against measles as a child. This puts you at much greater risk of catching or spreading the virus.

Check if you're fully immunised against measles. If you aren't or you're not sure, get your FREE immunisation at your GP or participating pharmacy.

Why worry?
Measles is a viral illness that spreads easily. About 90% of people who catch measles get a fever, cough, sore throat and red, itchy eyes. In some cases, it can lead to complications like pneumonia, ear infections and encephalitis. Measles can also lead to long-term health problems like deafness and brain damage.

Immunisation protection
Immunisation is the best way to protect yourself and your family from measles. It's a safe and effective way to prevent the disease. You can get your immunisation at your GP or participating pharmacy.

How effective vaccine?
The measles vaccine is 90% effective. This means that 90% of people who get the vaccine will be protected from measles.

Are there any side effects?
After your measles immunisation you may get a headache, slight fever, sore, and be generally unwell and tired. Most side effects don't last more than 3-5 days.

PROTECT AGAINST MEASLES

Are your tamariki under 5 protected against measles?

Over the past couple of years, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, many tamariki have missed their FREE measles vaccinations. Your child needs two doses of the measles vaccine to be fully protected. The first dose is usually given at 12 months and the second dose at 15 months of age.

If your child is more than 15 months old and hasn't had both doses of the measles vaccine, talk to your doctor or nurse practitioner.

Why is it important for tamariki to get their measles vaccinations?
Measles can be dangerous, particularly for children aged 5. It causes very serious and measles can cause pneumonia and brain infection. About 10% of children who miss their measles vaccinations will need hospitalisation. In a small number of cases, measles can be fatal.

What's measles?
Measles is a viral infection that's highly contagious. It spreads through coughing and sneezing. Symptoms include high fever, high fever, cough, runny nose, and red, watery eyes. The virus spreads by droplets of measles that start on the face and move down the body.

How effective vaccine?
The measles vaccine is 90% effective. This means that 90% of people who get the vaccine will be protected from measles.

How do I find out if my child has had it?
If your child has had measles, they will have a fever, cough, sore throat, and red, itchy eyes. They will also have a rash that starts on the face and moves down the body.

Getting your child's measles vaccine is easy and it's FREE
Your tamariki can get their FREE measles vaccination at your doctor or participating pharmacy. You can also get the measles vaccine at participating pharmacies. To get your tamariki their measles vaccination, talk to your doctor or visit your local pharmacy.





FREE meningococcal B (MenB) vaccines are available for all tamariki under 5 years old.</p> <p>How serious Meningococcal is a rare disease, but it can be life-threatening. People who get it often have serious symptoms like fever, rash, and joint pain.</p> <p>How to get it Meningococcal is spread through close contact with someone who has the bacteria. Meningococcal B immunisation
Paracetamol is recommended for pāpi under 2 years old

In New Zealand the meningococcal B (MenB) vaccine is also known as Bexsero. This vaccine can cause quite high fevers - particularly for pāpi under 2 years. To reduce the chance of your baby developing high fevers, it is recommended that paracetamol is given before and after immunisation.

Why is fever a side effect of vaccination?
Fever is a common side effect of many vaccines. It shows that the immune system is responding to the vaccine. Research shows that babies aged under 2 years are more likely to have a high fever with the Bexsero vaccine.

When should I give the paracetamol and how much?
It's important to give the exact amount recommended by the vaccinator and at the correct times. The two doses 6 hours apart are usually enough to stop high fevers.

The amount of paracetamol needed for each dose is based on your child's weight and changes as they grow. Therefore the vaccinator may need to check your baby's weight at each visit. MenB has three scheduled vaccinations.

If you need paracetamol talk to your vaccinator.

If you are using paracetamol that you already have at home, check the label on the bottle to make sure you are using the right strength for your child. The label **MUST** be 120mg/5mLs (not 500mg/5mLs). If you are not sure or unable to read the label do not use the medicine and talk to your vaccinator.


